# **CONSTRUCTION UPDATE**

## **Westbound Ventura Freeway (State Route 134) – New On-Ramp Construction at Hollywood Way**

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that beginning at approximately 6 a.m. Monday, September 29, 2008, the *southwest corner of Alameda Avenue and Hollywood Way in Burbank, including sidewalks, crosswalks and bridge portion, will be closed for a duration of approximately seven months, in order to perform bridge work related to new on-ramp construction.*

During this phase of construction:

- *Eastbound Alameda Avenue approaching Hollywood Way (bridge portion only) will be closed.*
- *Southbound Hollywood Way between Alameda Avenue and Riverside Drive (bridge portion only) will be closed.*

Signs and detours will be posted to assist motorists. Traffic will be detoured as follows:

- *For motorists traveling southbound on Hollywood Way approaching Alameda Avenue -- proceed west on Alameda Avenue, south on Pass Avenue, east on Riverside Drive, then back to Hollywood Way.*
- *For motorists traveling eastbound on Alameda Avenue approaching Hollywood Way -- veer right (east) on Riverside Drive, proceed north on Olive Avenue, then back to Alameda Avenue.*

In addition, by approximately 4 p.m. Monday, September 29, northbound Hollywood Way at Riverside Drive will re-open. This location was previously closed for bridge work.

There will be certain unavoidable inconveniences during this work, such as minor traffic delays and the possibility of noise. Caltrans is working to keep inconveniences to a minimum. This freeway improvement project will enhance safety, relieve congestion, and improve mobility and access to and from SR-134 and the Media District. Estimated completion is summer, 2010.
